## VINTAGE DETAILS

Regarded as one of the wettest growing seasons on record, 2017 experienced high levels of rain, which helped to flush soils and ensure minimal irrigation was required. This saw the growth of beautiful, lush and healthy canopies, slightly above average yields and resulted in a later than usual harvest. The fruit from this vintage showed excellent colour, character and optimum varietal flavour.

## TASTING NOTES Colour Deep red with a vibrant purple hue Aromas of redcurrant and satsuma plum intermingle **Nose** with delicate herbal tones Concentrated black fruits and cassis characters are **Palate** underpinned by a touch of subtle mint, and the wine finishes soft, silky and with wonderful length **Cellaring** Drink now until 2023 Enjoy with Roast lamb with mint sauce & roasted root vegetables
